

# Mauritania Telecom Fiber Optic Cable Connection



## Overview

The project includes construction of inter-urban fibre optic backbone links in the North, South and South-East of Mauritania, with international links to Mali. The deployment of the network is divided into 4 main segments which have a total estimated length of 1 660 km. The West Africa Regional Communications Infrastructure Program (WARCIP) Project helped to increase the geographical reach of broadband networks and reduce the costs of communications services in Mauritania. Deployed as part of the regional communications infrastructure program in West Africa, financed by the World Bank, it will help accelerate the country's digital transformation. ZTE Corporation, a provider of telecommunications technology. EllaLink announced the execution of agreement with the Ministère de la Transformation Numérique et de la Modernisation de l'Administration (MTNMA) of the Islamic Republic of Mauritania for the construction, operation and maintenance of a second international subsea cable that will directly connect.
