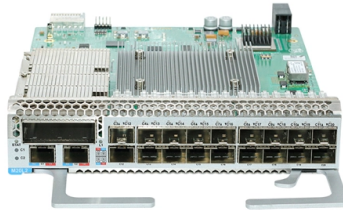

Without it, wastewater would flood one section of the drain field while starving others, causing premature. They are typically composed of four main components: the septic tank, the distribution box, the drain field (also known as leach field), and the soil.
